

2014 BASEBALL DATA DISK PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION FIX

If the 2014 Data Disk does not show the standings (and/or the Professional Baseball organization is not protected):

1. Replace the existing Org.Dat file in your ". . .\2014.WDD\ORG00001"* directory with the one attached to this post, it will correct the professional baseball organization.

*Depending on how the disk installed for you, it could be in either of these two directories (copy and paste directory into the address bar at the top of your Windows Explorer screen):

*C:\Documents and Settings\ALL Users\Documents\APBA Games\Baseball
\2014.WDD\ORG00001*

*Or C:\Documents and Settings\ALL Users\Documents\APBA Games\Baseball \U-
2014.WDD\ORG00001*

2014 Data Disk installed as a "U" disk:

If the disk installed as as "U" disk in BBW 5.75, you can change that using these instructions:

1. Rename the BBW Data Disk directory using Windows Explorer.
 - a. It is found in the "*C:\Documents and Settings\ALL Users\Documents\APBA Games\Baseball*" directory.
 - b. Scroll down to the U-2014.WDD folder. Rename that to 2014.WDD.
 - c. Then go to the "*C:\Documents and Settings\ALL Users\Documents\APBA Games\Baseball\Config files*" folder.
 - d. Edit the "APBA_BBW.ini" file in notepad.
 - i. Scroll down to the [Data Disks] section and find U-2014 season. It'll read something like a number such as
32872=0,,2014 Season,U-2014,0
 - ii. Change the U-2014 to 2014, then save.

The .ini file gets attached after the disk is loaded on the computer. Editing the file will replace the bad file, protect the Professional Org and display the Standings.
