Special Rules and Procedures for 1952-53:

1. Teams use 3 forward lines and 2 defensive pairs.
2. There are no substitution for coincidental minor and major penalties. Both teams must play short-handed.
3. Shortanded team does not have penalized player come out of penalty box if a power play is scored; the entire minor penalty time must be served.
4. There is no overtime. Games tied after 60 minutes are recorded as a tie for each team.
5. Teams allowed to dress 15 skaters per game.
6. Gamers on the power play may play any forward they choose as a 4th forward in a defenseman position even if the forward is not rated for that position.
