***Used primarily or exclusively as a relief pitcher. Should be used seldomly or not at all as a starter. (Pitchers with asterisks following their grades on the player cards themselves should be used exclusively in relief, unless they have split ratings.) For most realistic results the frequency of use of starting pitchers should be determined by the order of their listings above, not by the grade ratings on their cards. Error Rating = E+3**

IMPORTANT- Rule Clarification: When the numbers 7, 8 and/or 11 are found in THE SECOND COLUMN of a player card, they are NOT SUBJECT TO NORMAL PITCHERS' GRADE CHANGES. For example, a SECOND-COLUMN 8 on the "BASES EMPTY" board is always a "SINGLE to left center" NOT MATTER WHAT THE PITCHER'S GRADE.
