

APBA BASEBALL FAN:

You may now order the 1980 edition of the player cards for your APBA Major League Baseball Game. This edition is based upon the complete, official records of the 1979 major league baseball season.

The enclosed roster sheet lists the players in the 1980 edition of the APBA baseball cards. Please do not lose it if you intend to purchase the cards. None will be included when your cards are mailed. These cards are printed and assembled in complete sets of 520 cards—26 teams, 20 player cards per team—and they must be sold in complete sets only. We cannot fill orders for one team or one league.

IMPORTANT: IF YOU OWN AN APBA MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL MASTER GAME, SEE THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS NOTICE.

CARD PRICE \$11.50—GAME PRICE \$18.50

The complete new set of 520 players' cards in twenty-six team envelopes sells for \$11.50 postpaid in the U.S. Residents of Pennsylvania must add 6% sales tax, for a total of \$12.19. The price for all foreign purchasers is \$12.50 in U.S. funds. Servicemen with APO or FPO addresses pay the regular \$11.50 price.

If you want a complete new game, the price is \$18.50 in the U.S. (\$19.61 for Penna. residents) and \$20.25 in U.S. funds for all foreign buyers. This is the basic APBA Major League Baseball Game, NOT THE MASTER GAME, and we strongly recommend that anyone who is not familiar with APBA Baseball buy our basic game before trying the Master Game. The Master Game is geared to the fan who already understands the basic game completely. Also, the basic game includes the new 1980 edition card set, WHILE THE MASTER GAME DOES NOT.

XB79 — 6 EXTRA CARDS FOR EVERY TEAM — \$3.75

One hundred fifty-six additional players are available for use with the 1980 edition. Based on the 1979 season's records, they are printed on the same card stock and in the same colors as the regular set, but with twelve players to a perforated sheet. Simply tear the sheets apart and the individual cards are ready for use.

A list of the names of these players is enclosed. The price is \$3.75 for the entire set of 156. For Penna. residents, it's \$3.98 and foreign, \$4.00. Ask for set XB79.

NEW — 1948 AND 1916 SEASONS' BASEBALL CARD SETS

We guarantee delivery by April 30 of any order we receive in January. This does not necessarily mean you won't get your order until April 30 (chances are you'll get it earlier, perhaps much earlier), BUT IT DOES MEAN WE CAN'T GUARANTEE DELIVERY BEFORE THEN. And it is impossible for us to respond to inquiries about orders (either by letter or telephone), REGARDLESS OF THE REASON FOR YOUR INQUIRY, until after May 15 when our files are back in order.

This policy applies to ANY order placed at this time of year.

We regret we can't give special attention to those with birthdays, vacations, etc. in February and March, but it is a fact that to expedite an order for one person would force us to delay an order for another. We mail our orders, therefore, strictly in the sequence we receive them. Please don't ask for special attention to your order because, in fairness to everyone, we simply can't provide it.

We can't even begin to fill orders, of course, until we receive the new cards from our printer in mid-February. So if there is an unusual delay in receiving your order, we ask for your patience and your understanding of our clerical difficulties during our rush season.

Since service charges must be paid on foreign checks, even when written in U.S. dollars, we must require that payments coming from all foreign countries be made by money orders issued for U.S. dollars.

NO C.O.D. ORDERS ARE ACCEPTED, AND NO REFUNDS, EXCHANGES, CANCELLATIONS OR REVISIONS OF ORDERS WILL BE MADE ONCE WE HAVE RECEIVED YOUR ORDER. WE CAN MAKE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY.

APBA BASEBALL MASTER GAME FAN:

Master Symbols — \$2.00 Per Season

The 1980 edition (1979 season) symbols for the APBA Major League Baseball Master Game are available for \$2.00 (\$2.12 in Penna., \$2.25 foreign). These symbols are computed for use with the new 1980 edition card set advertised on the reverse side of this flyer.

Also on sale at the same prices are symbols for the new 1948 and 1916 card sets, as well as for the following seasons' card sets: 1978, 1977, 1976, 1975, 1974, 1973, 1972, 1949, 1941, 1938, 1930, 1927, 1922, 1908.

Each of these sets includes symbols for every player in the card set for the baseball season represented, including XB players (except 1949, 1941 and 1930, which do not include XB's). You can get master symbols for the XB30, XB41 and XB49 additional player sets for 75c each (plus 6% in Penna., plus 10% foreign). There are symbols for all 96 players in each set. Keep in mind our \$2.00 minimum order requirement.

NOTE: On the order coupon on the reverse side of this page, all symbols are identified by SEASON, not by APBA edition year!

Symbols for all Great Teams of the Past and the World Series Card Set

Symbols for every one of the 47 APBA Great Teams of the Past can be purchased for 25c per team. Pennsylvania buyers must add 6% sales tax for each team, and foreign purchasers must add 10%. There are symbols for all 20 players on each team. If you aren't familiar with the APBA Great Teams, ask us for Form 80.

All 240 players in the World Series Card Set are represented by master symbols as well. (If you're not familiar with this set, ask us for Form 80.) Symbols are included for all 20 players on each of the 12 World Series teams. The price for this set of symbols is \$1.50. (It's \$1.59 in Pennsylvania and \$1.65 foreign.)

IMPORTANT: Any of the symbols mentioned above are virtually useless unless you already have the APBA cards to which they correspond. For example, the 1973 season symbols won't be any good to you without the 1973 season cards.

The World Series Card Set and all Great Teams of the Past are available from APBA, but some of the complete seasons listed above ARE NOT. The flyer advertising the 1916 season lists all available past seasons' card sets.

Injury factors are included for all teams not originally issued with them.

If You Haven't Heard of the Master Game, Ask Us About It!

If you're a recent addition or a recent returnee to our mailing list, you may not even know what the Baseball Master Game is. If that's the case, simply ask us for free literature on the Master Game.

Briefly, the Master Game contains playing boards far more numerous and far more complex than those in the basic game. **IT CONTAINS NO PLAYER CARDS EXCEPT THE 1951 GIANT AND DODGER TEAMS**, but it does include the 1980 edition (1979 season) symbols. To play the 1980 edition game, you need to purchase the cards as well. (SEE SPECIAL OFFER BELOW!) You must be thoroughly familiar with both the basic APBA Major League Baseball Game and the game of baseball itself before you can attempt to play the Master Game; **DON'T BUY IT UNLESS YOU QUALIFY ON BOTH COUNTS.**

The price of the Baseball Master Game is \$16.25 (\$17.23 in Pennsylvania, \$17.75 to foreign purchasers).
