## NEW EDITION (520 CARDS): \$15.00 --- XB82 (156 EXTRA CARDS): \$4.50

The new 1983 edition consists of 520 player cards (20 for each of the 26 big league teams) and costs \$15,00, Pennsylvania residents must add 6% sales tax, for a total of \$15.90. Additional processing time and increased mailing expenses require that we charge \$16.50 for mailing outside the U.S. (But servicemen with APO or FPO addresses pay the regular \$15.00 price.) All above prices are complete ———we add nothing for postage or handling.

Set XB82 provides 6 more 1983 edition player cards for every team, a total of 156 in all. Its price is \$4.50 (\$4.77 in Penna,

\$5.00 foreign).

See the enclosed vellow "lineup sheet" and the small white "additional player" sheet for rosters of the players in the regular and XB sets. Hang on to these sheets for future reference, because you won't get another copy of either one with your cards.

Both regular and XB cards are printed and assembled in complete sets, and that's how they're sold. We can't break sets to sell single teams or even one league.

## COMPLETE BASEBALL GAME (INCLUDING NEW CARDS) ---- \$24.95

The price of a complete new APBA Major League Baseball Game, including the 1983 edition card set (but not XB82), is \$24.95 (\$26.45 in Penna., \$27.50 foreign). THIS IS THE BASIC GAME, NOT THE MASTER GAME.

# **APBA MASTER GAME FAN:**

The 1983 edition (1982 season) symbols for the APBA Major League Baseball Master Game can be ordered now for \$2.50 (\$2.65 in Penna., \$2.75 foreign). These symbols are designed to be used with the new 1983 edition card set advertised on the reverse side of this flyer.

### Symbols for Other Seasons, Too

Also on sale at the same prices are symbols for the new 1932 and 1913 seasons' card sets, as well as for the following other seasons' card sets: 1981, 1980, 1979, 1978, 1977, 1976, 1974, 1973, 1972, 1949, 1948, 1941, 1938, 1934, 1930, 1927, 1924, 1922, 1919, 1916, 1908.

Each of these sets includes symbols for every player in the card set for the baseball season represented, including XB players

where applicable (except 1949, 1941 and 1930, which do not include XB's).

You can get master symbols for the XB30, XB41 and XB49 additional player sets for 75 cents each (plus 6% in Penna., plus 10% foreign). There are symbols for all 96 players in each set. Please keep in mind our \$3.00 minimum order requirement.

NOTE: On the order coupon on the reverse side of this page, all symbols are identified by SEASON, not by APBA edition year! And any of the symbols mentioned above are virtually useless unless you already have the APBA cards to which they correspond. For example, the 1973 season symbols won't be much good to you without the 1973 season cards.

The Original Franchise All-Stars card set, World Series card set and all Great Teams of the Past are available from APBA, but cards for some of the seasons listed above ARE NOT. Available seasons are listed on the reverse side of the flyer headed "APBA Saddle Racing Fan."

Injury factors are included with the symbols for all teams not originally issued with injury factors on their cards.

## And Symbols for Original Franchise All-Stars, Great Teams & World Series Set

We have symbols for the Original Franchise All-Stars card set. These symbols cost \$3.00 (\$3.18 in Penna., \$3.30 foreign). Symbols for every one of the 55 APBA Great Teams of the Past can be purchased for 50 cents per team. Pennsylvania buyers must add 6% sales tax for each team, and foreign purchasers must add 10%. There are symbols for all 20 players on each team. All 240 players in the World Series card set are represented by master symbols as well. Symbols are included for all 20 players on each of the 12 World Series teams. The price for this set of symbols is \$2.00. (It's \$2.12 in Pennsylvania and \$2.20 foreign.)

## If You're Not Familiar with the Master Game, Ask Us for a Free Description!

If you're a recent addition or a recent returnee to our mailing list, you may not know what the Baseball Master Game is. If that's

the case, simply ask us for free literature on the Master Game.

The Master Game features playing boards far more numerous and far more complex than those in the basic game. IT CONTAINS NO PLAYER CARDS EXCEPT THE 1951 GIANT AND DODGER TEAMS, but it does include the 1983 edition (1982 season) symbols (which are used in conjunction with the new edition of cards when playing the Master Game). To play the 1983 edition Master Game, therefore, you need to purchase those cards as well. You must be thoroughly familiar with both the basic APBA Major League Baseball Game and the game of baseball itself before you can attempt to play the Master Game; be sure you are before you buy. We do not make exchanges or refunds.

The price of the Baseball Master Game is \$17.75 (\$18.82 in Pennsylvania, \$19.50 to foreign purchasers).
