

NEW: 1952 SEASON BASEBALL CARDS

Yes, it's another new baseball card set from APBA. This 1952 season set, calculated with present-day APBA card-making formulas, includes 400 player cards — 25 for every one of the 16 big league teams in 1952.

The 1952 season was climaxed by a dramatic New York - Brooklyn World Series since immortalized by Roger Kahn in "The Boys of Summer." The Bronx Bombers prevailed in seven games. In the seventh game, unheralded Bob Kuzava came out of the bullpen to retire Duke Snider and Jackie Robinson with the bases loaded to protect a 4-2 lead in the seventh inning. Kuzava also put down the Bums in the eighth and ninth in his lone Series appearance that year.

This is a card set, not a complete game, and it costs \$17.00 (\$18.02 in Pennsylvania, \$18.70 foreign). Team envelopes and a lineup sheet are included.

The 1950, 1953, 1954 and 1957 seasons' baseball card sets, likewise made with modern APBA formulas, remain in stock, each at the same price as the 1952 set. 1952 leaders follow:
