Our policy is to keep prices of all our products as low as our costs allow. For this reason, we accept no credit cards and do no C.O.D. mailing. We make no refunds or exchanges, and we don't cancel or revise orders. SO PLEASE BE SURE YOU WANT WHAT YOU ORDER.

IF WE RECEIVE YOUR ORDER IN JANUARY. YOU'LL HAVE IT BY APRIL 15. This doesn't necessarily mean you won't get your order until April 15 (chances are you'll get it earlier, perhaps as soon as February), BUT IT DOES MEAN WE CAN'T GUARANTEE DELIVERY BEFORE THEN. And it is impossible for us to respond to inquiries (letter or telephone) about orders until April 30, when we will have our files in order again.

EXCEPTION: Orders including new computer merchandise may possibly take several weeks longer to process, since our past experience has been that software publishers take several weeks longer than board game suppliers to deliver new items to us. For what it's worth, though, American School Publishers has advised us that the 1989 data disk will be available much earlier than the new season's disk has been in past years. American School Publishers has replaced Random House as the game's publisher.

We regret we can't give special attention to any particular order, but it is a fact that to expedite an order for one person would force us to delay one for another. Please don't ask for special attention to your order because, in fairness to everyone, we simply can't provide it.

We begin to fill orders immediately upon receipt of the new cards from our printer in mid-February. We work substantial overtime to get every order to the customer as quickly as we possibly can. We ask for your patience and your understanding during our busiest time of the year. (After April 15, delivery may take a maximum of six weeks, but probably much less.)

Customers living in Pennsylvania must add 6% sales tax to all prices, and residents of all foreign countries must add 10%. (But APO or

FPO addressees pay the regular U.S. prices.)
