

IMPORTANT – RULE CLARIFICATION: When the numbers 7,8, and/or 11 are found in THE SECOND COLUMN of a player card, they are NOT SUBJECT TO NORMAL PITCHERS' GRADE CHANGES. For example, a SECOND-COLUMN 8 on the "BASES EMPTY" board is always a "SINGLE to left center" NO MATTER WHAT THE PITCHERS' GRADE IS.

For most realistic results the frequency of starting pitchers should be determined by the order of their listings above, not by the grade ratings on their cards.
