\*Used primarily or exclusively as a relief pitcher. Should seldom be used as a starter. (Pitchers with asterisks following their grades on the player cards themselves should be used exclusively in relief, unless they have separate starting and relieving grades.) For most realistic results the frequency of use of starting pitchers should be determined by the order of their listings above, not by the grade ratings on their cards.
