The following individual great teams from past years are available for use with the APBA Pro Basketball Game:

1. APBA's All-Time NBA Team A (No. ATK)—Ten of the greatest performers in league history, each card based on the player's best overall season. Paul Arizin, Elgin Baylor, Bob Cousy, Bob Davies, Sam Jones, George Mikan, Bob Pettit, Bill Russell, Dolph Schayes, and Bill Sharman—all ten will excel in APBA just as they did in their real-life NBA careers.

2. APBA's All-Time NBA Team B (No. BTK)—Ten more of the greats of yesteryear, again based on each player's top all-around year. 1. 1952-53 New York Knickerbockers vs. Minneapolis Lakers: A Laker powerhouse with George Mikan, Slater Martin and Vern Mikkelsen against a game Knick club led by Carl Braun, Harry Gallatin, and Dick and Al McGuire.

2. 1954-55 Syracuse Nationals vs. Fort Wayne Pistons: Two very evenly matched squads—two of the Nat stand-outs were Dolph Schayes and Paul Seymour, while Larry Foust and George Yardley paced the Pistons.

3. 1957-58 Boston Celtics vs. St. Louis Hawks: A young Bill Russell battling Bob Pettit in his prime, with the Celtics' Bob Cousy, Bill Sharman and Frank Ramsey and the Hawks' Cliff Hagan and Ed Macauley just a few of the other stars in the series.

4. 1961-62 Boston Celtics vs. Los Angeles Lakers: The perennial champion Celtics, with Russell, Cousy, Tom Heinsohn and the Joneses, Sam and K. C., opposed by the youthful Lakers, boasting names like Elgin Baylor, Jerry West and Rudy LaRusso.

5. 1966-67 Philadelphia 76ers vs. San Francisco Warriors: A new Philadelphia team versus a transported Philadelphia club, featuring the 76ers' Wilt Chamberlain, Hal Greer and Billy Cunningham and the Warriors' Rick Barry, Nate Thurmond and Al Attles.

6. 1969-70 New York Knickerbockers vs. Los Angeles Lakers: One of the most exciting final series in recent years—Walt Frazier, Willis Reed, Dave DeBusschere & Co. challenge the Lakers of Chamberlain, Baylor and West.
