AFBA Pro Bowling is a thoroughly comprehensive reproduction of the aport of bowling. A case in point is the variety of spare feaves (or aimply spares) included in the game. Mathematically, 1,023 different spares are possible in bowling. A large number of those, nowery, are inconceivable in practice. One quite obvious example is a 1-2,54-67-8-910 spare——the free (midello) pin down and all others standing.

APBA provides for all single-pin spares and every sensible ombination. That's 467 individually listed spares, each of hich comes up with nearly the same frequency as in real life.

### Innovative APBA Techniques to Determine Spares

To identify which pins remain standing after an unsuccess-tul strike attempt, APBA Bowling sometimes employs entirely original "multiple result" techniques. This system reduces (often orastically) the chances for uncommon spares and spits.

When a bowler fails to strike, one, two, three or lourgin spares result most free quently, but even many of the three- and four-pin combinations are awfully unusual.


