Special Rules and Procedures for 1940-41:

1. Teams use 3 forward lines and 2 defensive pairs. Teams dressed 14 skaters plus a goalie.
2. The icing rule does not exist; if play result is an icing, then non-icing team gets the puck and gives it to a player of their choice. Both teams may change lines.
3. Teams that are shorthanded do not have the player released from the penalty box if a goal is scored. The player must serve his entire penalty.
4. There is no substitution for coincidental minor and major penalties. Both teams must play short handed.
5. If tied after 60 minutes, a 10 minute overtime period is played in its entirety. No sudden death. If still tied after the 10 minutes of overtime, the game is declared a tie.
6. For statistical purposes, misconduct penalties are not charged to individual player penalty minutes.
